His is grateful for your prayers!

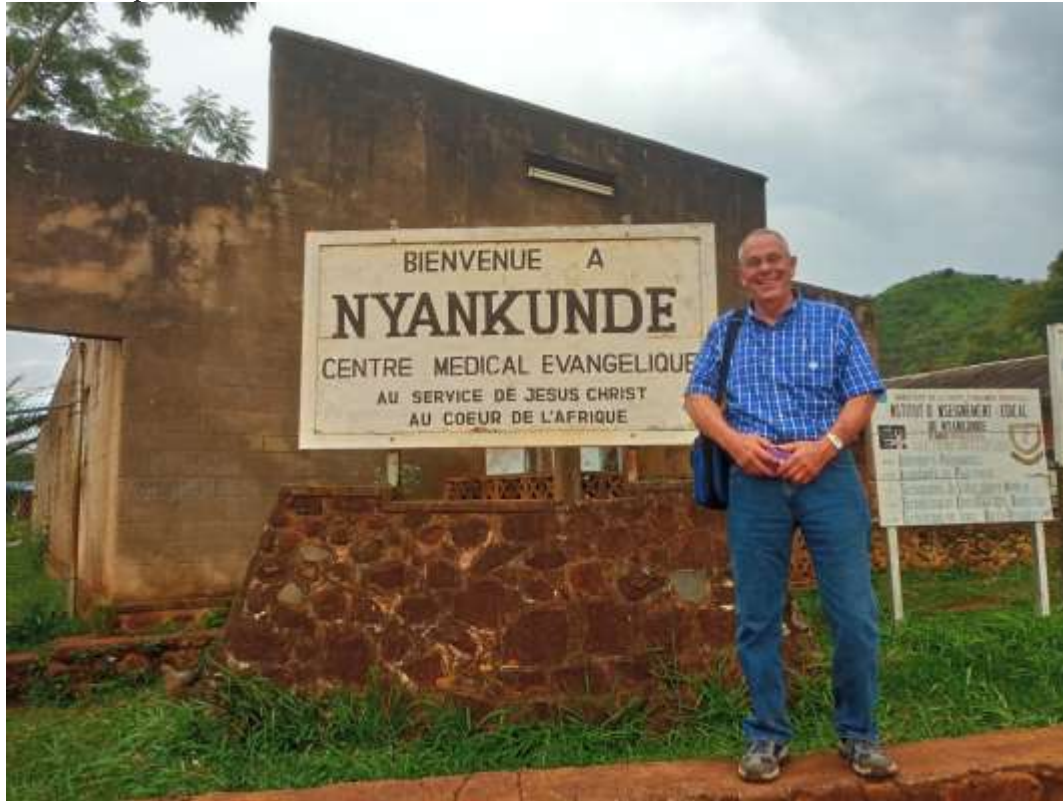
Loading his baggage in the Cessna for the final flight from Bunia to the hospital.
