## Focus on Diaconal Ministries Habitat For Humanity – Huron Valley



The House of Faith that our church helps to sponsor has already had one build day this Fall and will be having another build day on Saturday, November 17. This year the House of Faith is located in Ann Arbor. Each year our church sponsors a House of Faith along with First Presbyterian Church of Ann Arbor, Westminster Presbyterian Church of Ann Arbor, and First Baptist Church of Ypsilanti.

In the 2017 – 2018 fiscal year 17 new homeowners were able to purchase homes through Habitat for Humanity of Huron Valley. In addition, Habitat for Humanity of Huron Valley provided various different home improvement programs to 962 families, provided financial counseling to 284 individuals, and 1881 people served with Habitat for Humanity of Huron Valley through their Community Development Program during the 2017 – 2018 fiscal year.
