- 1. We lament discrimination and prejudice, both corporate and personal, that denies basic human rights or restricts opportunities to flourish.
- 2. We affirm that every human being is created in the image of God and therefore has equal value and worth.
- 3. We affirm our belief that discrimination based on race, sexual orientation and socioeconomic status is a rejection of God's intention that we live in unity.
- 4. We affirm our intention to invite and welcome everyone who comes through our doors to join us in responding to God's invitation to become fully-devoted followers of Jesus Christ.
- 5. We affirm that we are called by God to work for justice and equality and to oppose discrimination in all its forms -- and thus we also affirm our intention to advocate for the needs of those who suffer discrimination in our community, our country and our world.
- 6. We affirm that God is calling us to reach across the lines of race, sexual orientation and socioeconomic status with respect, grace, understanding and love.
